This includes commissioned client work and work otherwise purchased for private enjoyment.














The intention was to make something equal parts whimsical, cozy, groovy, and grounded.






Nick sent me photos of the other artwork in his collection as an inspiration for the colors, and otherwise gave free reign to create something whimsical and expansive and full of intrigue.

Jack asked for a vibrant colorway to compliment his home furnishings, and a sky reminiscent of the sunset.








WELLSPRING III








A NOTE ON SMALLNESS
